# GENERAL ORDERS

# TRAFFIC ENGINEERING

**PURPOSE:**

While the Sheriff's office is not directly responsible for traffic engineering, close cooperation and coordination with municipal, county, and state traffic engineers is essential to the maintenance of a safe and efficient roadway system.

**TRANSPORTATION  
PLANNING:**

When requested to do so, the Traffic Unit is to participate in the management of planning county or regional transportation systems. The Traffic Unit is to assist in conducting traffic surveys on county roads to assist county planners in determining traffic volumes and speed.

**TRAFFIC  
ENGINEERING  
PROBLEMS:**

Every deputy is to report any traffic engineering-related problems, such as:

1. Traffic control lights out.
2. Street signs down.
3. Street design problems.
4. Any information that would improve conditions and safety for the general public.

Any engineering problem noted is to be reported to Communications. On occasion, it may be necessary to report problems in written correspondence to the proper agency or department.

**TRAFFIC COLLISION  
REPORTS:**

Traffic collision reports are forwarded to the South Carolina Department of Public Safety for their analysis and engineering recommendations.
